What Proposition B WILL do:

- Add unnecessary laws and regulations
- Set a size limit for any dog breeder
- Put many good dog breeders out of business
- Decrease selection and increase prices for dogs

What Proposition B WILL NOT do:

- Stop unlicensed breeders who do not comply with current laws and regulations
- Provide personnel and funding for better inspections and enforcement of the proposed and existing laws
- Allow many breeders who properly care for their dogs to continue providing pets to the public

“The American Kennel Club strongly believes that ALL dogs—not just those who are part of a breeding program—deserve:

- *Sufficient food and clean water;*
- *Necessary veterinary care;*
- *Sufficient housing, including protection from the elements;*
- *Sufficient space to turn and stretch freely, lie down and extend his or her limbs;*
- *Regular exercise; and*
- *Adequate rest between breeding cycles.*

However the way in which some of these terms are defined in the proposed Missouri ballot measure do absolutely nothing to improve the wellbeing of animals; instead, it would add excessive expenses to responsible breeders who strive to produce well-bred family pets at a reasonable cost.”
